use a sharps disposal bin!



DO NOT

Throw loose sharps in garbage



Put sharps in recycling bin



Flush sharps down toilet



Throw sharps in bushes or parks



DO use a sharps disposal bin



A sharps disposal bin works like a mailbox and is used to dispose of loose sharps and containers with sharps inside.



Bring sharps to a 24-hour bin located outdoors at:

To the right of the main entrance

To the left of the back entrance

By the main entrance
